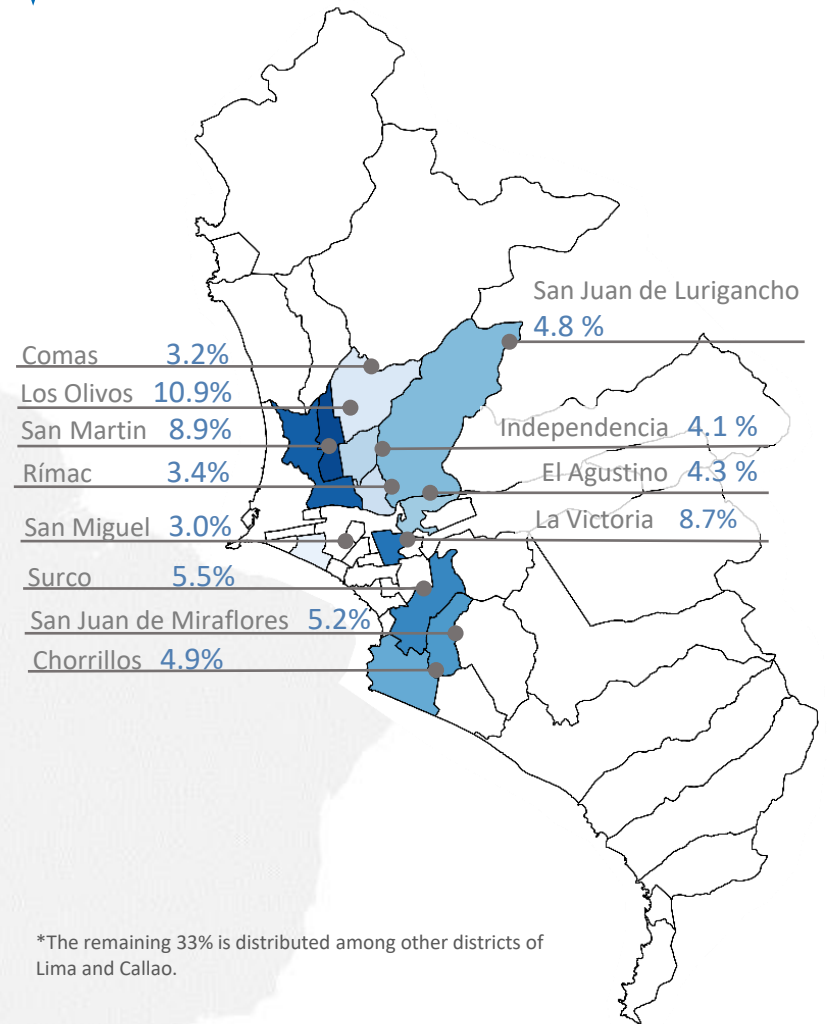

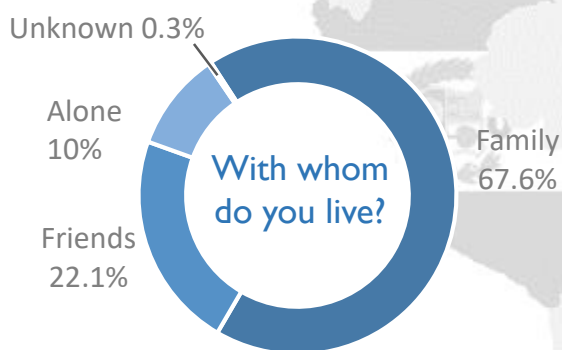

95% is paying a housing rent

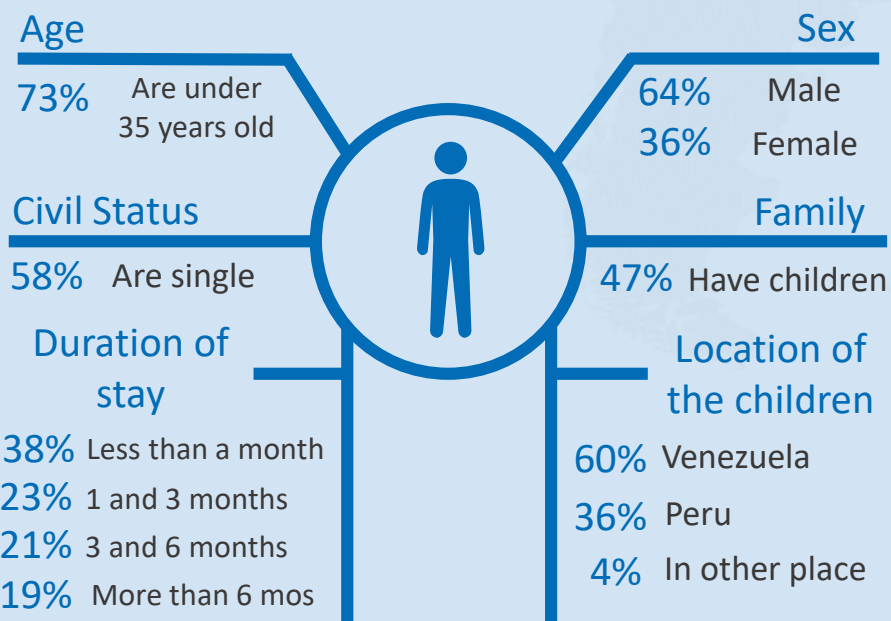
ECONOMY
