

Additionally, 1060 UAC (14 of which pending transfer have been reported as living in informal/insecure housing conditions such as living temporarily in apartments with others, living in squats, being homeless and moving frequently between different types of accommodation.

The above number includes 122 UAC with no location reported by the referral agent. EKKA is in the process of updating this information.

Safe zones*


Current: 10 Safe Zones for UAC with total 300 places

Hotels**

- Current: 17 Hotels for UAC with total 660 places
- *Safe Zones are designated supervised spaces within accommodation sites which provide UAC with 24/7 emergency protection and care. They should be used as short term (maximum 3 months) measures to care for UAC in light of the insufficient number of available shelter places. Safe Zone priority is given to UAC in detention as well as other vulnerable children, in line with their best interestee.
- **Hotels are emergency accommodation spaces being used as a measure to care for UAC in light of the insufficient number of available shelter places. Priority is given to UAC in Reception and Identification Centers.






Referrals processed* per month in 2019 (updated on a monthly basis)
