

# **ITALY** Sea arrivals dashboard


### Overview

Between 1 January and 29 February 2020, 2,553 persons arrived in Italy by sea. This is a 874% increase in sea arrivals compared to the same period last year (262). In February 2020, 1,213 individuals reached Italian shores, compared to 60 in February 2019. 363 persons reached Italy in one day only (Pozzallo 2 February) representing 30% of the total arrivals in February.



#### Yearly sea arrivals


January to February, 2017-2020



### Nationality of arrivals

In the first two months of 2020, 17% of persons who arrived by sea originated from Bangladesh, followed by Algeria (12%), Côte d'Ivoire (11%), Sudan (10%), Somalia (7%), Guinea (5%), Mali (5%), Morocco (4%), Tunisia (4%), and Nigeria (3%). In the same period last year, the most common nationalities of sea arrivals were Bangladesh, Tunisia, Algeria, Iraq, Senegal, Guinea, Islamic Republic of Iran, Egypt, Sudan, Pakistan, The Gambia. In February, there was an increase (120%) of Bengali arrivals (303) compared to January (137), as well as for Sudanese (173) and Somali (110) nationals compared to January 2019 increased respectively of 140% and 77%.


#### Most common nationalities of arrivals - January 2019 to February 2020





## Country of embarkation


In the first two months of 2020, 72% of sea arrivals in Italy (1,830 persons) departed from Libya, followed by 12% (314 persons) from Tunisia, 11% (290 persons) from Algeria, and 5% (119 persons) from Greece. Notably, in February last year only 39 people departed from Algeria. Compared to January, there have been more departures from Libya (7) than Algeria (5) however in this month, more women embarked in Libya (61) than Tunisia (12).

Between 1 January and 29 February 2020, most sea arrivals were adult men (68%), followed by unaccompanied and separated children (18%), adult women (9%) and accompanied children (5%). In February 2019 no women arrived in Italy, while in the first two months of 2020 a total of 231 arrived.

In 2020 so far, most UASC arriving by sea originated from Bangladesh (138), followed by Guinea (53), Côte d'Ivoire (52), Somalia (41), Eritrea (28), Mali (21) and Sudan (21). In February 2019, UASC originated only from Tunisia.
