4: Services Advisor and Back End Access	<ul> <li>Services Advisor is an inter-agency tool developed by UNHCR to display available services provided by organizations by each location and service.         <ul> <li>Sectors need to follow up with the partners to collect their updated services.</li> <li>Activities reported under ActivityInfo should be listed in Services Advisor by the implementing agency.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Back end access to Services Advisor is demonstrated.         <ul> <li>Questions</li> </ul> </li> <li>What is the difference between the different types of user roles (especially User and Contact)?         <ul> <li>The main difference is that User can access the back-end and update services, while Contact will be used for referral purposes only.</li> <li>If an organization is financially supporting other organization, who should add the services?
