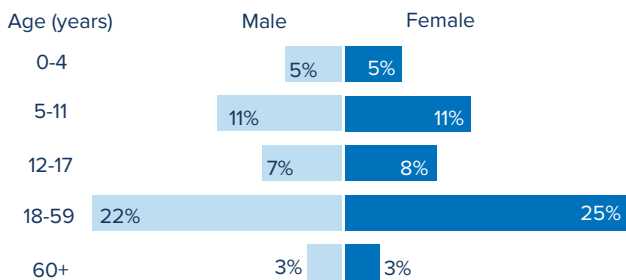

AGE-GENDER BREAKDOWN⁴

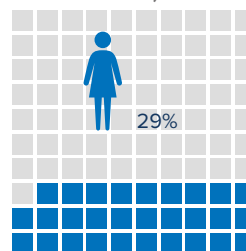

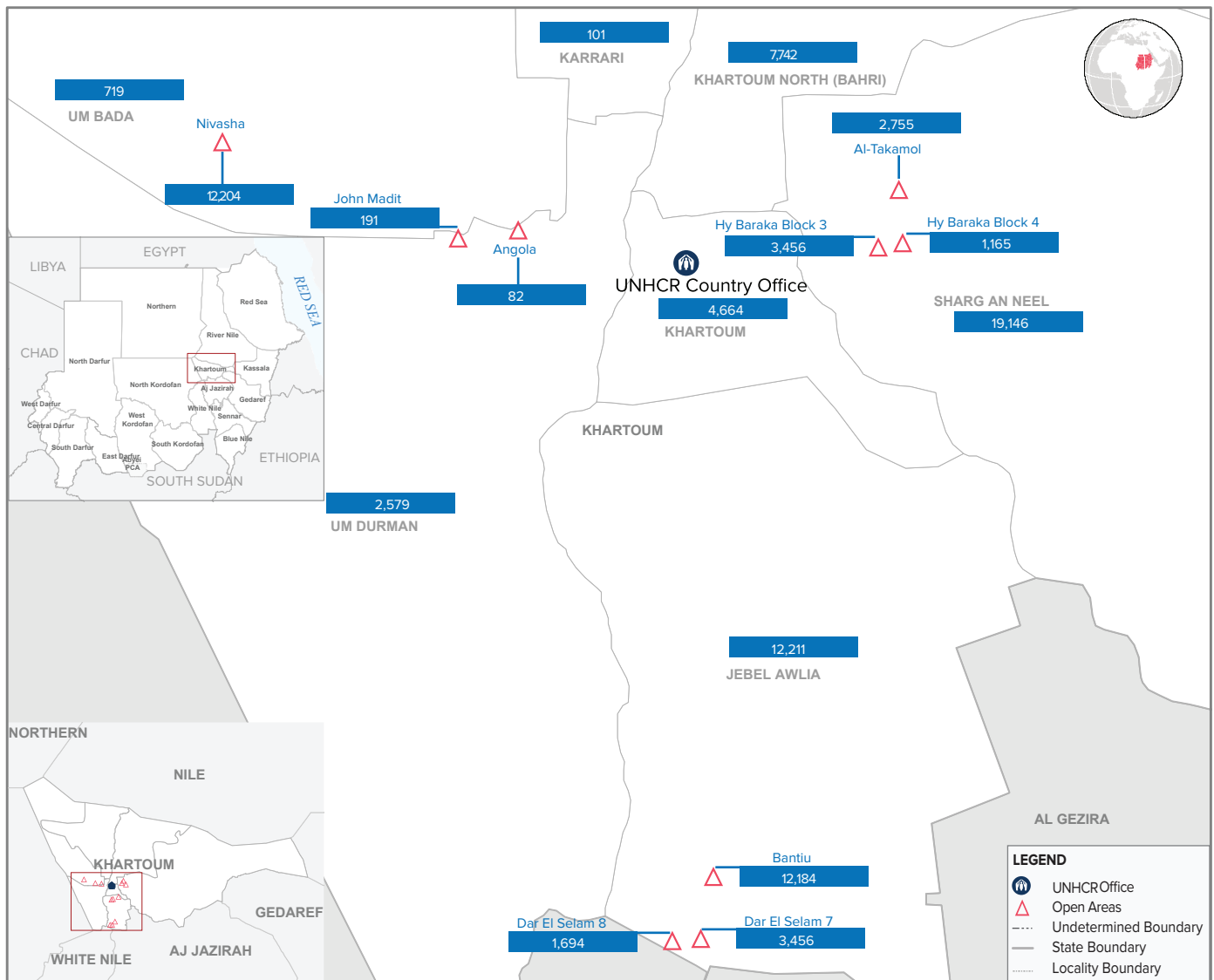
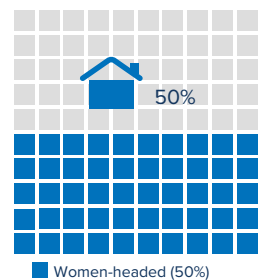
SCHOOL-AGE CHILDREN (6-17 YRS)⁴

HOUSEHOLD DISTRIBUTION⁴



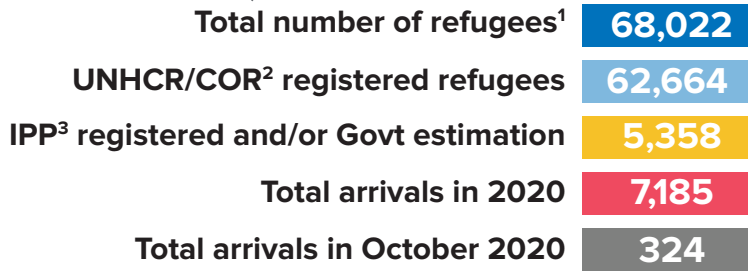

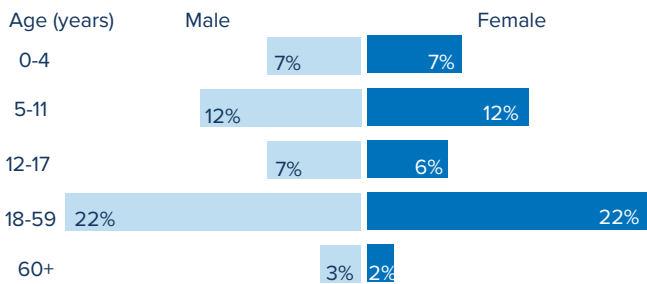

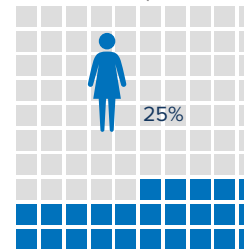

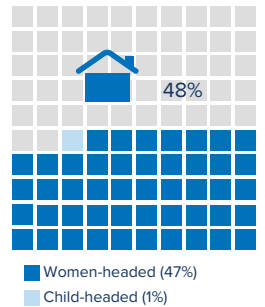

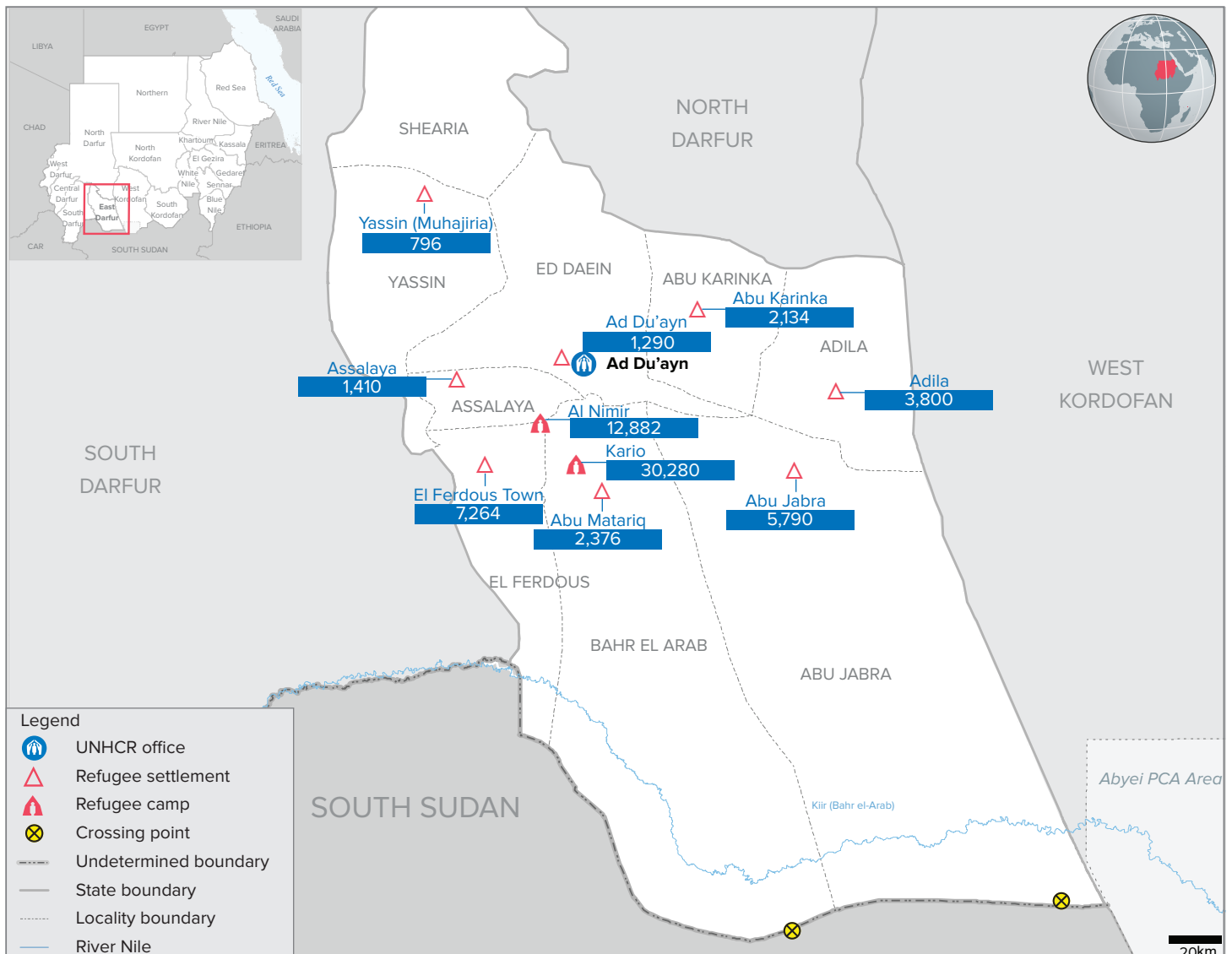
REPRODUCTIVE- AGE WOMEN/GIRLS (13-49 YRS)⁴

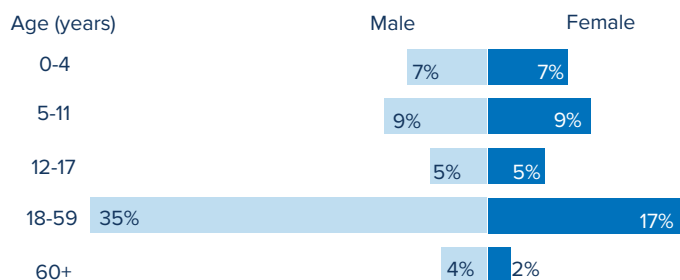

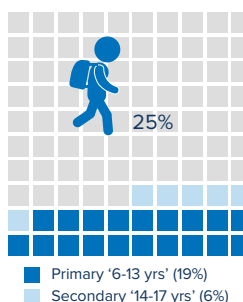

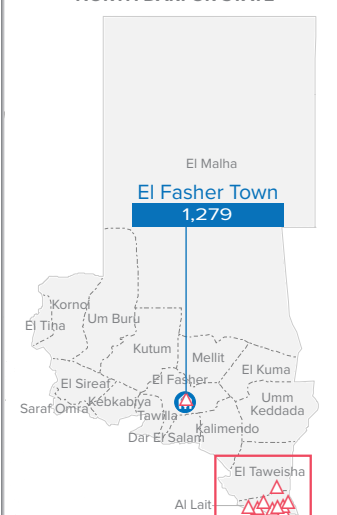

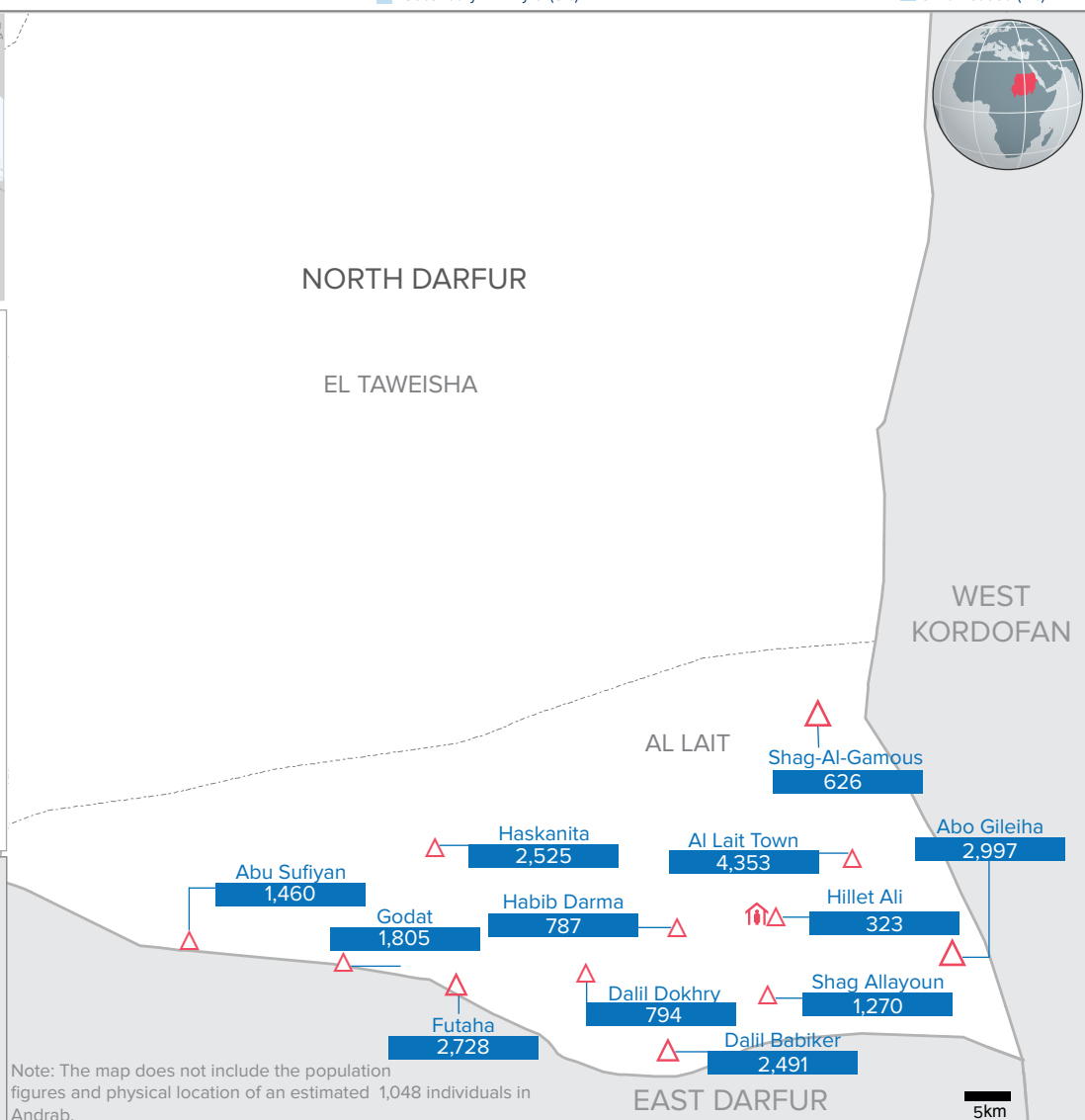

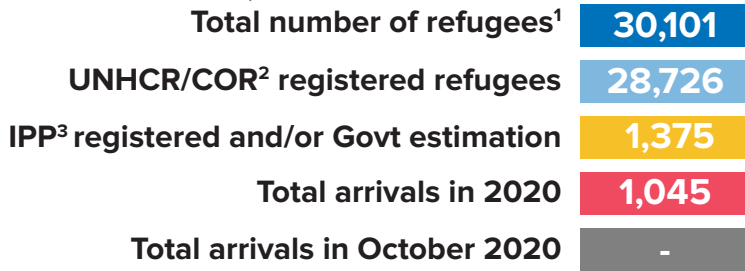

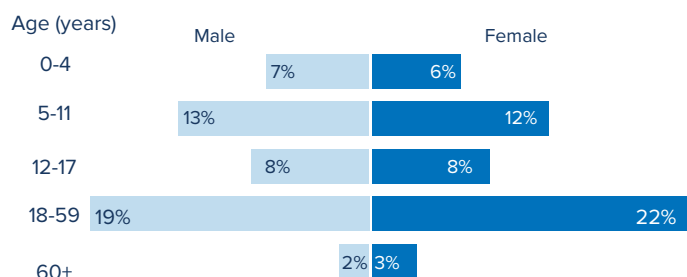

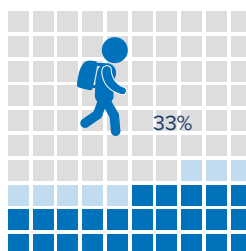

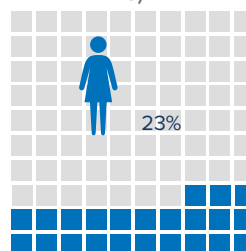


SCHOOL-AGE CHILDREN (6-17 YRS)⁴

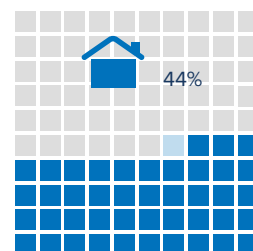

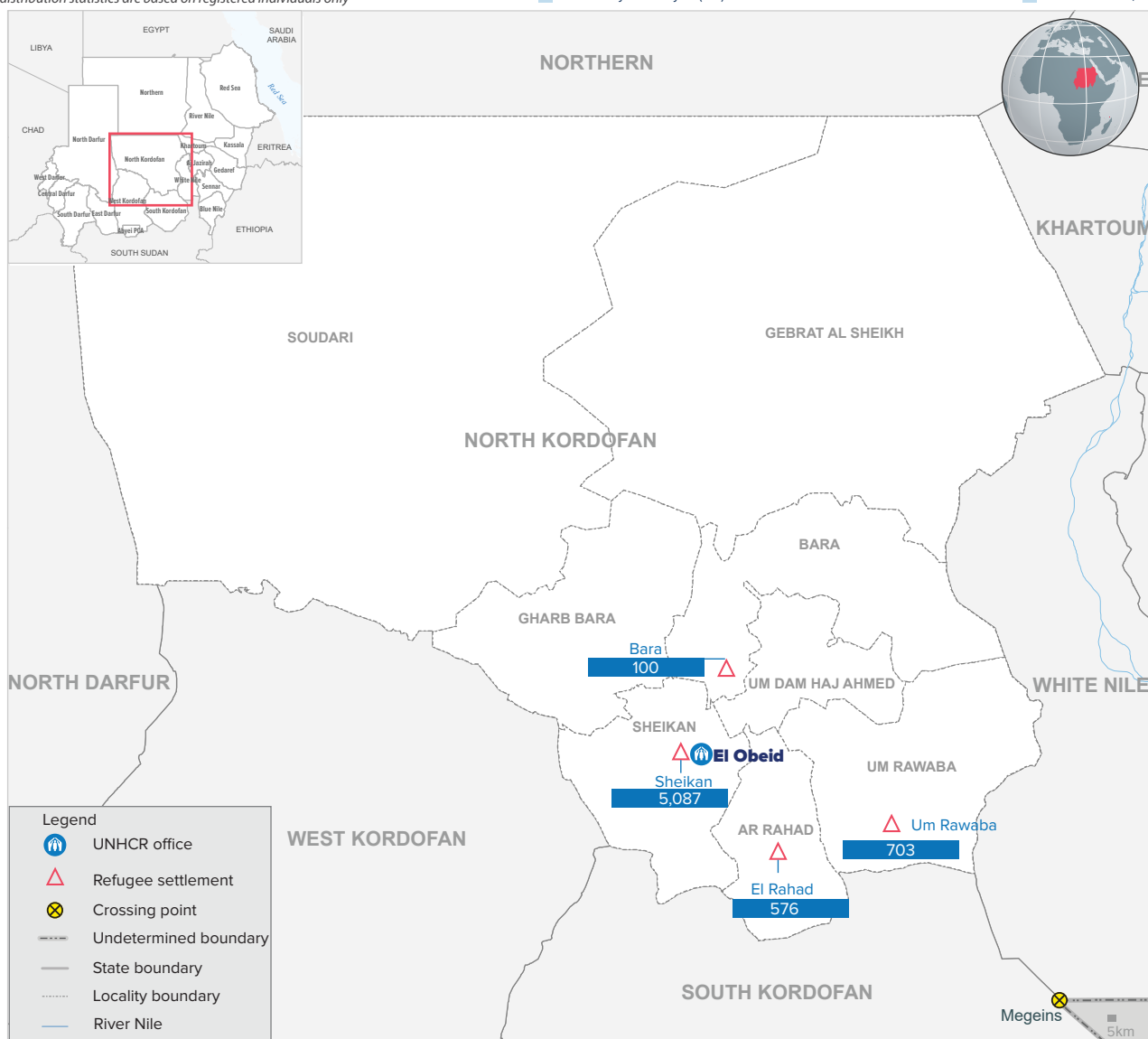


HOUSEHOLD DISTRIBUTION⁴

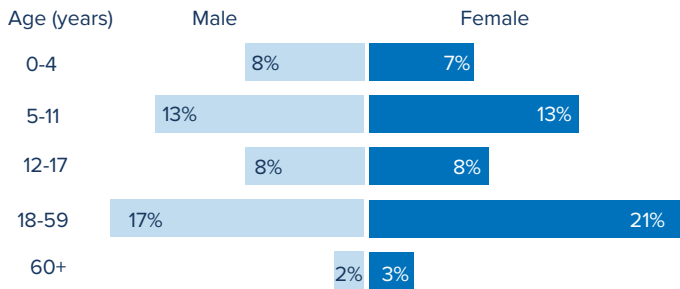

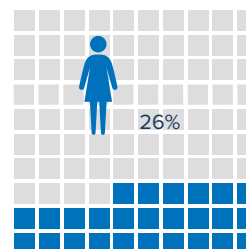

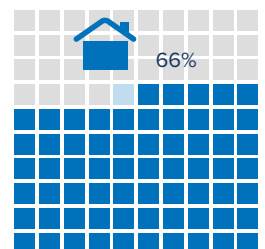

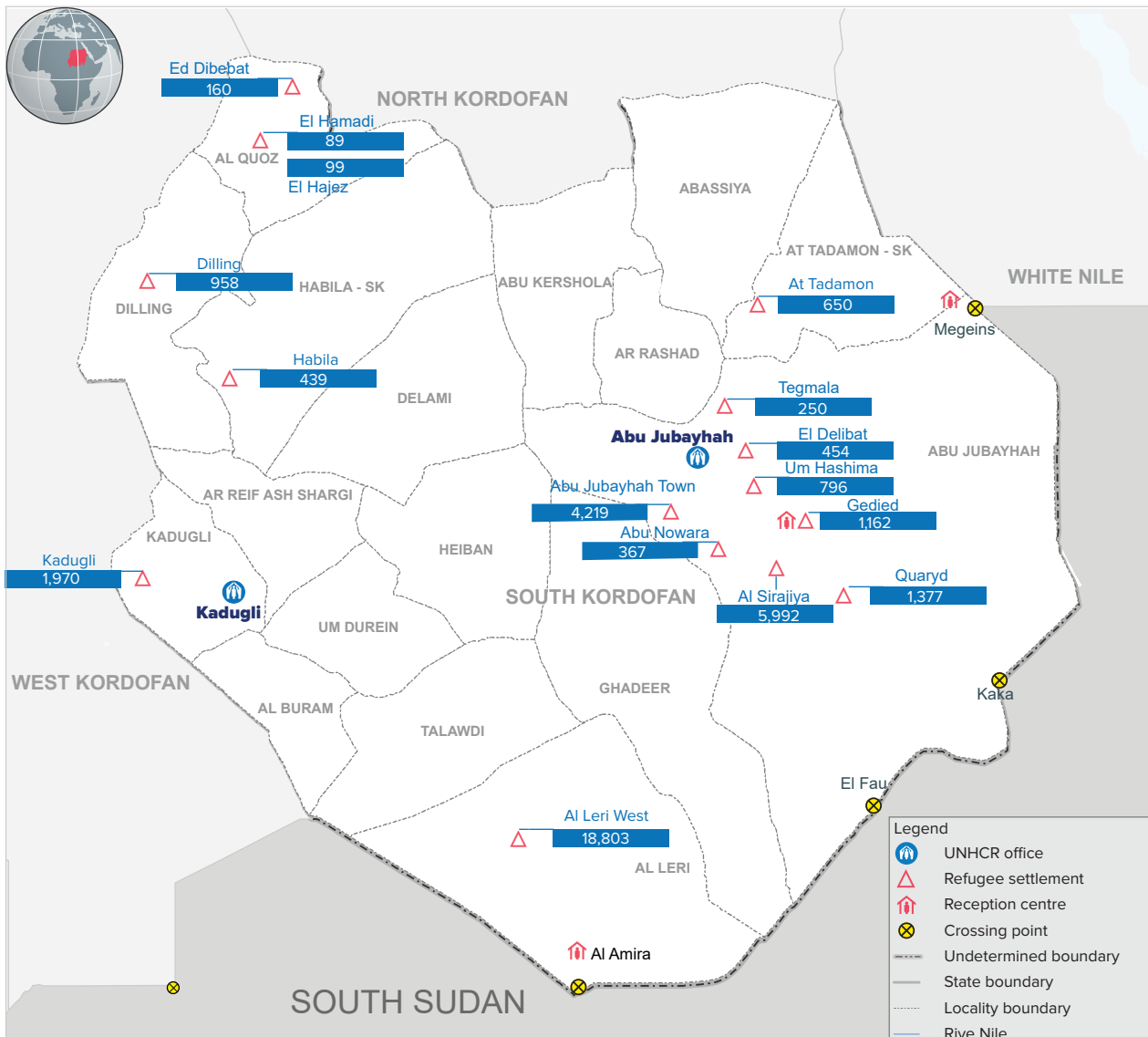

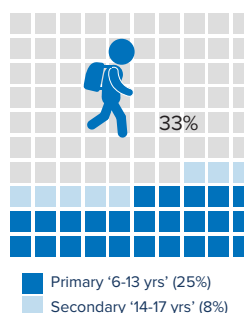

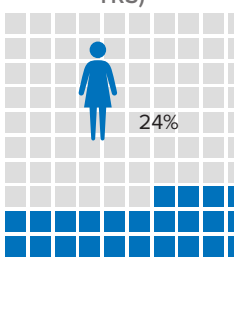
AGE-GENDER BREAKDOWN⁴



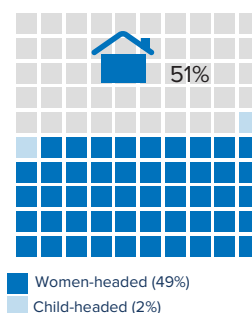

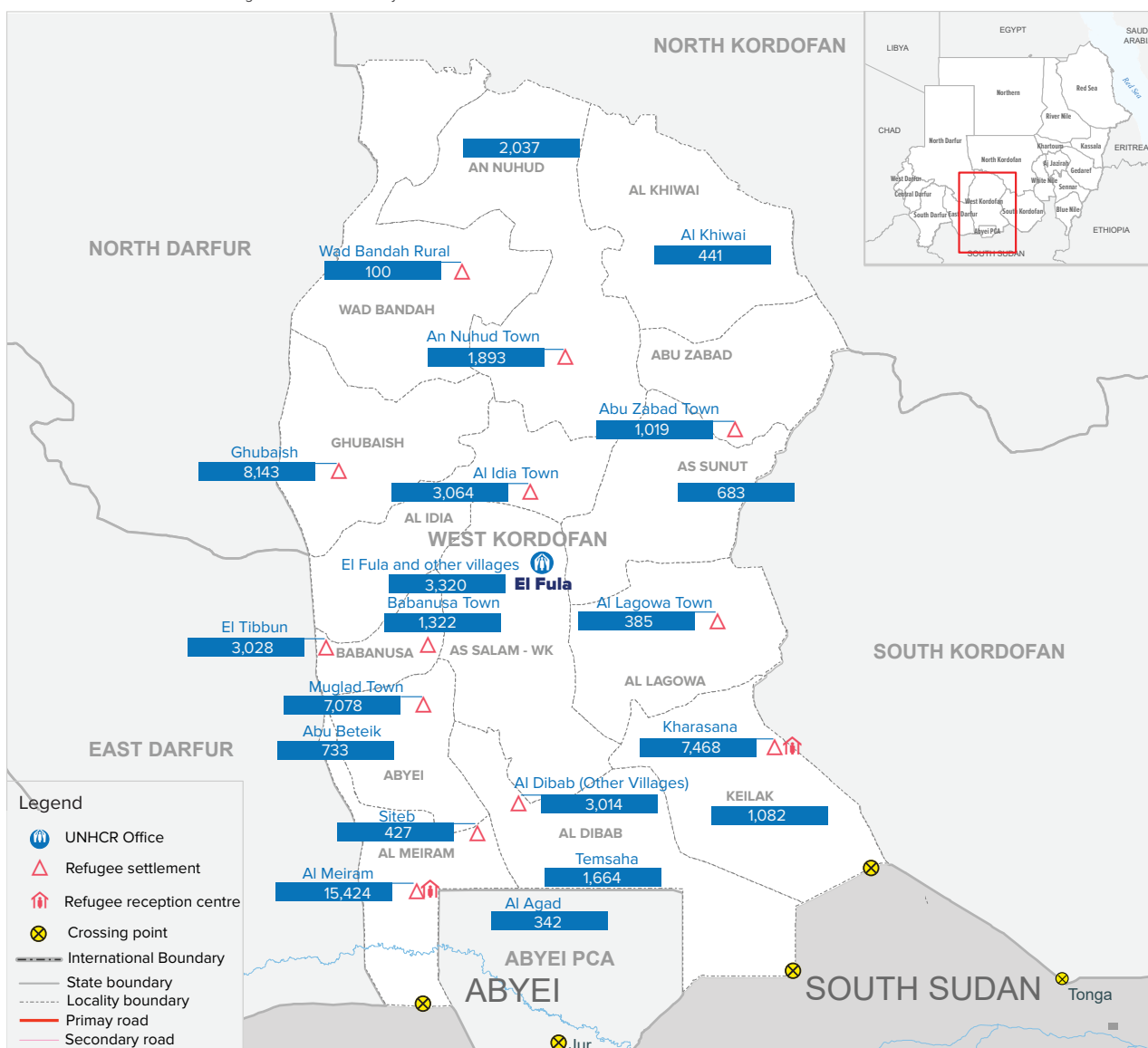

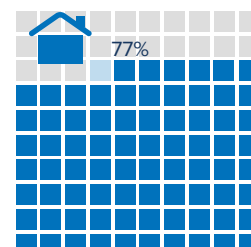

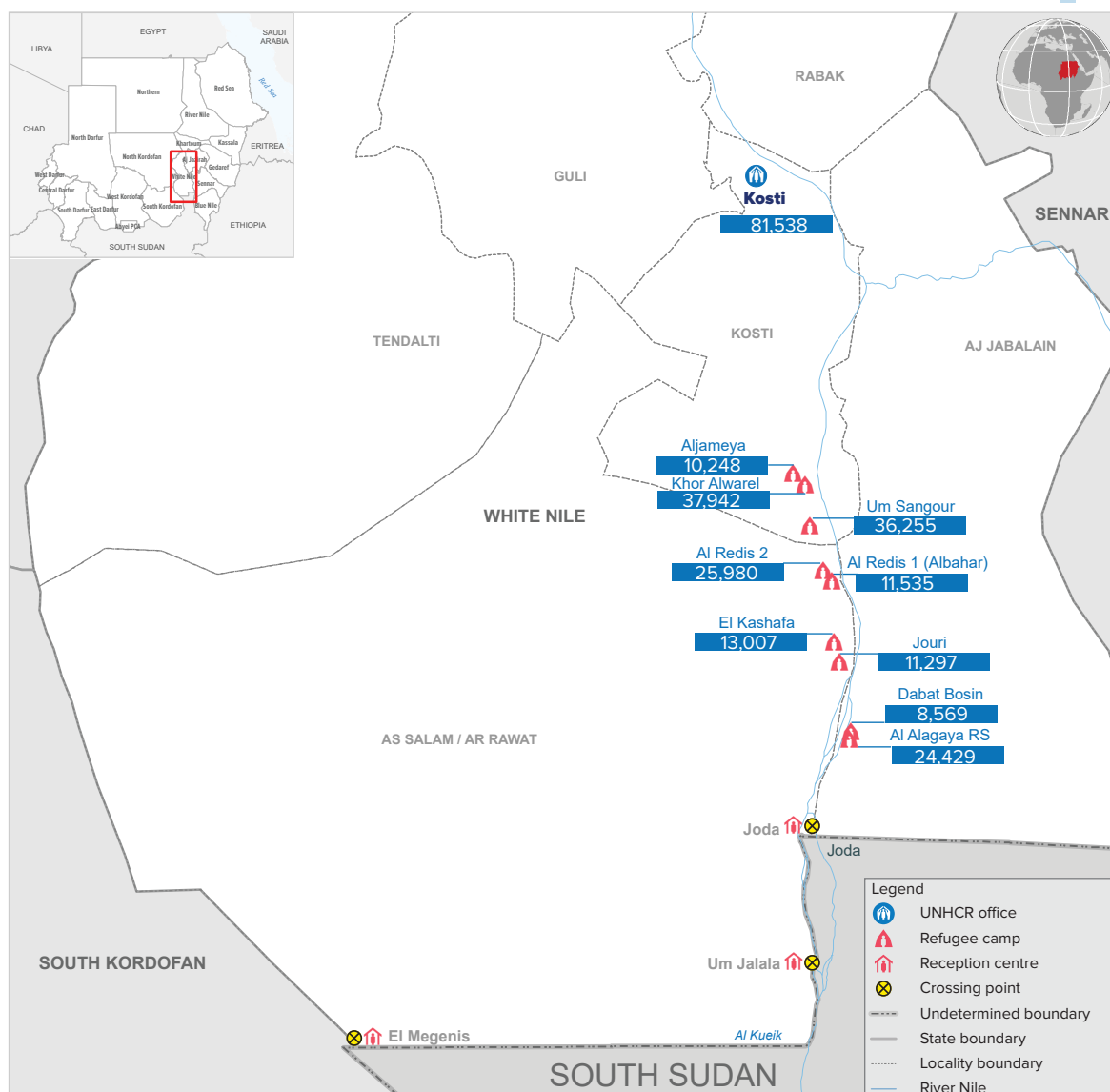
