






- Winter is coming...Harsh winter months bring additional cost for families to meet basic needs (heater, gas, blankets)
- COVID-19 pandemic & lockdown had negative impact across multi-sectoral vulnerability:
 - Socio-economic (loss of livelihood, high level of debt)
 - Protection (GBV incidents, child labor)
- Jordan Humanitarian Fund (JHF) 2nd allocation will focus on Winterization assistance (basic needs, shelter) + Protection
 - Priority will be given to projects that address the needs of persons/households with several protection vulnerabilities UNHO

Protection Prioritization Criteria

Priority 1: All 5 elements: women at risk, child labour, elderly, single caregiver, SMC

Priority 2: Any combination of four elements eg, child marriage, elderly, single parent, disability

Priority 3: Any three of the elements

Priority 4: Any two of the elements

Priority 5: Any one of the elements

Priority 6: None of the elements

Combine scores rather than creating a weighted score

Level 1: Severely Vulnerable



Level 2: Highly Vulnerable
