

KEY FIGURES







The East and Horn of Africa and Great Lakes region is host to some 4.58 million refugees and asylum seekers, majority (2.10 million) from South Sudan. A further 8.08 million people are internally displaced in the region, as a natural conflict and disasters. Some 126,900 refugees returned to their countries of origin in 2019.




