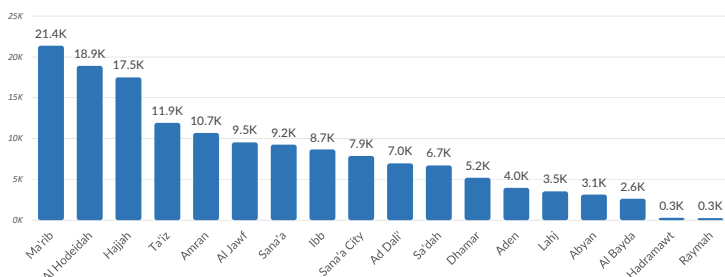
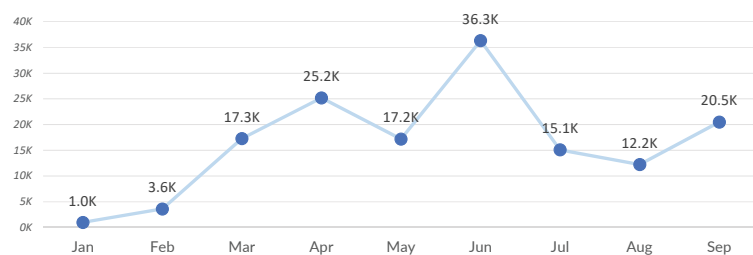

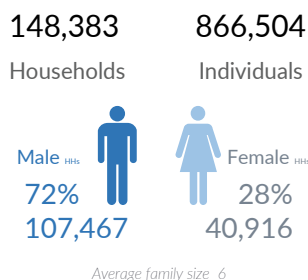
### Households assessed by governorate



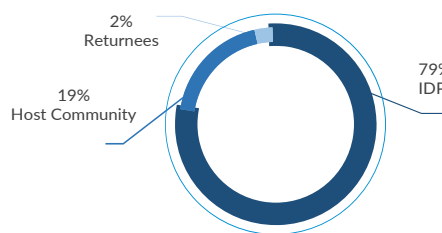
### Households assessed by month



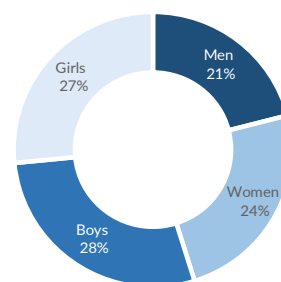
### Breakdown of assessed households



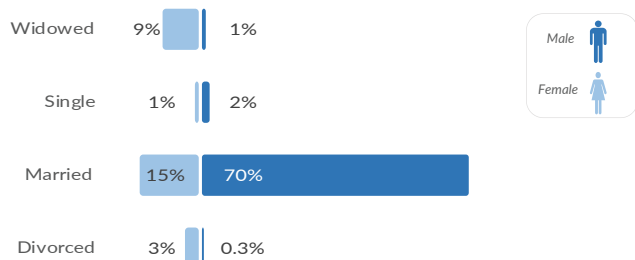
### Displacement profile



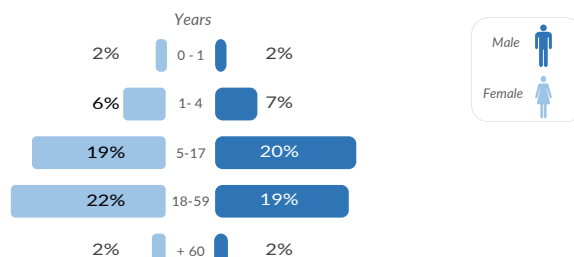
### Ages and gender ratio in family



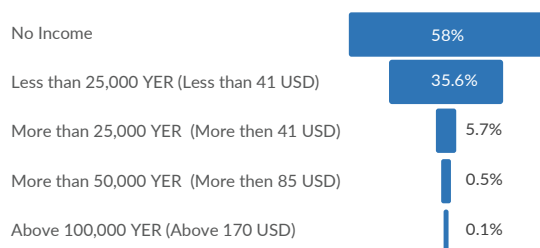
### Marital status of the respondent



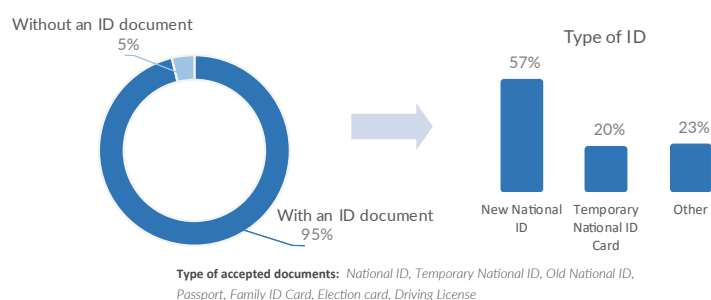
### Age and gender breakdown of families



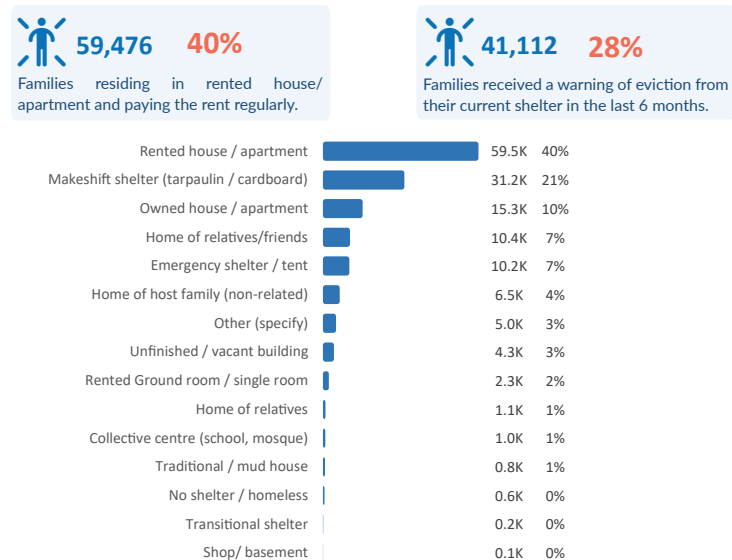
### Average monthly income by assessed household

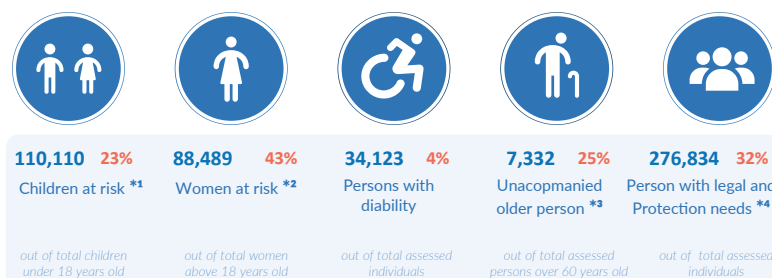

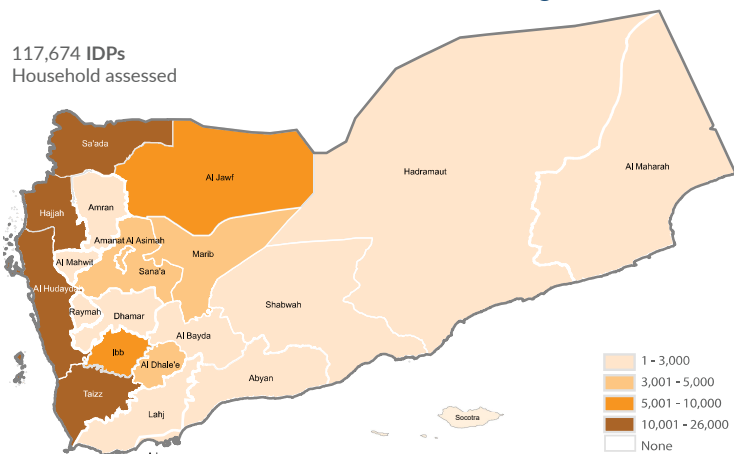

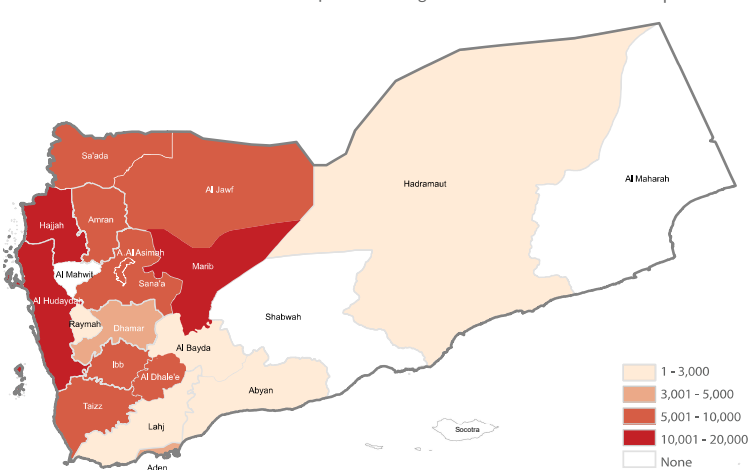

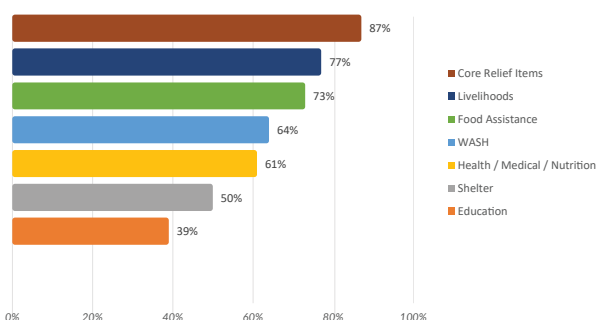
