
# **KEY FIGURES** 267,415 BURUNDIAN REFUGEES

ove total reflects the refugee population covered by the Burundi Regional Refugee Response Plan a es Burundian refugees who fled since April 2015, as well as some 37,000 Burundian refugees asylum in the region prior to April 2015. In addition to the population above, there are some 20,579 Burund es and asylum seekers in Kenya, 8,948 in Mozambique, 11,241 in Malawi, 9,870 in South Africa and 7,086 in nbia who are assisted within the respective country-level programmes. A further 42,200 Burun who have lived for decades in Tanzania, no longer receive assistance and are not included in these figures


### ASSISTED RETURNS BY MONTH


