

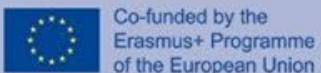

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The Young Journalists Programme

- Started from 15 Afghan girls in Schisto Refugee Camp in 2016.
- Developed into a regular programme including ***Migratory Birds*** newspaper and web radio ***Dandelion***.
- Provides multiple benefits: Technical skills development, getting a voice in media and new technologies, participation in democratic processes, building self-esteem and self-confidence, critical thinking, etc.
- Recognised Good Practice by the Council of Europe.



EFIVOS project

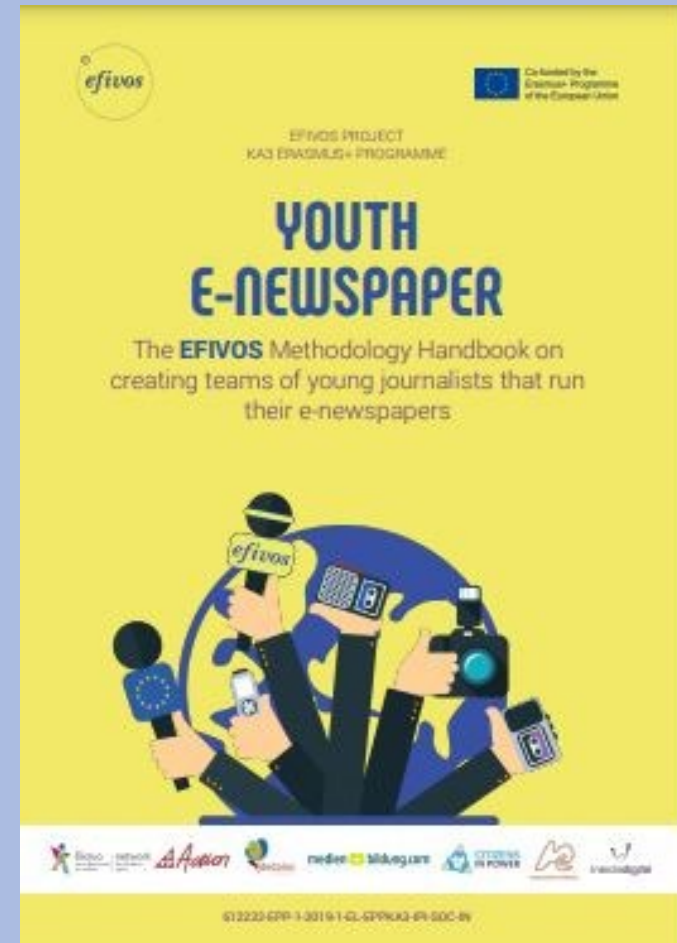
- Taking the *Young Journalists* programme to the next level
- Involving 7 partners from 6 European countries (Greece, Cyprus, Italy, Spain, Germany and Sweden)
- Main aims are:
 - 1.To digitize the newspaper
 - 2.To record and share the YJ methodology
 - 3.To train trainers on the methodology
 - 4.To train young people from disadvantaged backgrounds to produce their own digital journalistic content

The 8 Components of EFIVOS


- Editorial management & How to hold an Editorial Meeting

- Development of online tools, an online newspaper


Methodology Handbook

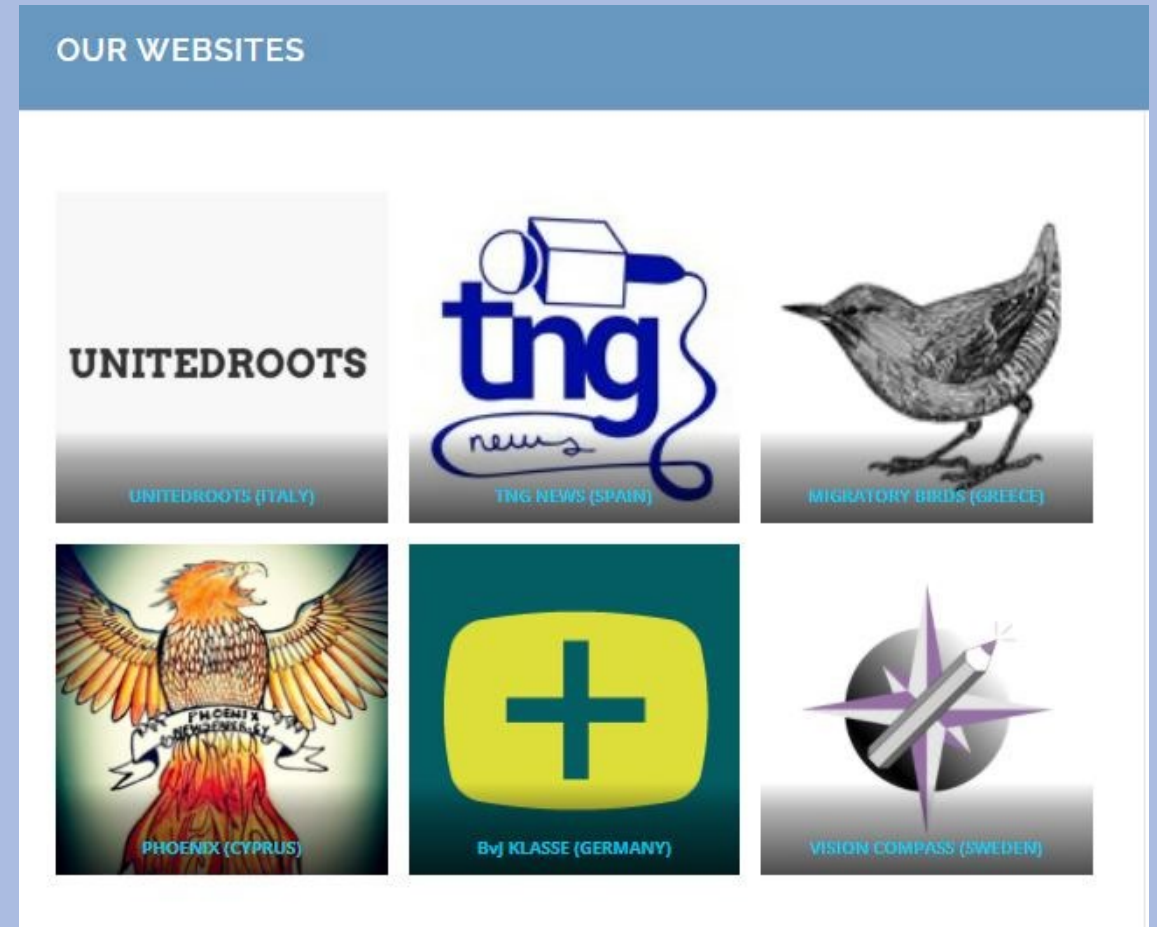

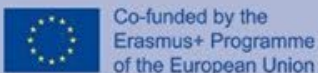
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
