



SGBV Field Sub-Working Group – Za’atari

SGBV – FSWG final endorsement: SGBV – FSWG ToR finalized and endorsed by the group. Refugee coordination matrix for refugee response in Jordan is yet to attached as annex. **Action Point:** Chair to disseminate and share TOR with coordination bodies including SGBV Sub-Working Group, Protection Working Group, CP working group and CMC. TOR to be updated on the UNHCR portal.

Orientations on GBV basics and the referral pathways for district/field based service providers and refugees committees/refugees-based structures: To increase potential for timely and effective identification, disclosure and response to survivors of GBV and others at-risk the group members, with the support of the inter-agency standing committees on the SOPs, agreed to organize and roll-out orientations on the referral pathway and GBV basic for the district level service providers and the refugees based structures and committees.

- **Tentatively starting date for roll-out:** three weeks to one month.
- **Actors to be targeted are:** Protection and non-protection actors. Protection Actors include: a) protection committees (refugees based protection structures), b) Protection staff working at the district level and c) protection outreach (including volunteers). Non-protection actors include: a) Non-protection service providers working at the district level, b) non-protection outreach (including volunteers) and c) non-protection refugees’ community based structures/committees. Orientations will also be presented at the district level meetings.
- **Length of orientation:** Each orientation for protection actors will last 3 hours. Each orientation for non-protection actors will last 1.5 hours. Presentations at each district level meeting will last 20 minutes.
- **Trainers’ methodology:** Between 6 and 12 staff will be responsible for rolling out the orientations at the district level. Between 1 and 2 staff will be in-charge of 2 districts. Only protection staff or GBV specialized staff will be selected to roll-out the orientations at the district level. Most likely this will be IRC, UNHCR and IMC staff. Selected staff will receive a 3 hours training before starting the rolling-out of the orientations.
- **Materials:** a card/brochure inclusive of contact details and protection lines will be disseminated during the orientations.
- **Planning / Next steps** – a) Mapping out of actors. **Action Point:** Chair to distribute table for mapping out actor. GBV focal points to map out actors at the district level, inclusive of estimated numbers of interested participants. GBV focal points to share with SGBV members compiled table by the next SGBV meeting. B) list of protection staff/specialized GBV staff interested in rolling-out the SOPs at the district levels. **Action Points:** Agencies to share number and name of protection staff/specialized GBV staff interested in rolling out the SOPs. List to be shared with Elena Del Fabbro, CCing Amanda Melville, Ana Belen Anguita and Maria Margherita Maglietti by Monday, 19th May 2014.

AOB: Amani Campaign: as part of the inter-agency messages the Amani campaign was developed to disseminate message on early marriages. The Amani Campaign uses posters and social media tools to facilitate discussions and activities on early marriages and promote consultations with leaders and other key members in the community. **Action Point:** GBV members to bring forward discussions on how to integrate the Amani Campaign through Za'atari based activities. **Drop Box:** SGBV drop box for Jordan and Za'atari activated. **Action Point:** Chair to share link and access with group members. **Membership:** List of CP/GBV membership finalized. **Action Point:** Chair to share with group members' final list. **Sharia Court:** Sharia court opened in the Za'atari. Further briefing and updates to be discussed at the CP/GBV joint meeting.
