JORISS letter	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The first support letter was sent to MoPIC on 5 Nov. A second letter will be sent to MoPIC by the 20th of Nov. winterization partners who want to be included in the second letter are encouraged to share their project information (JORISS number, Project titles and date of submission) with Ruba Saleh (salehru@unhcr.org).
Winterization dashboard	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> As of fifth of Nov, Winterization Task force partners have blocked 56 percent of eligible cases on RAIS. UNHCR has not blocked the full extent of its budget in order to grant organisations time to assess and block their own cases loads. UNHCR has capacity to absorb the remaining cases and this will be implemented in mid-late November. Winterization partners who requested cases form UNHCR will have until November 28th to block and confirm assistances before UNHCR provides for the remaining caseload on the 30th November. Winterization partners will be requested to unblock the cases they will not assist by the 28th of Nov so UNHCR can provide the cases with the winterization support. A weekly dashboard with information extracted form RASI will be shared with the partners.
PDM Task force update	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The PDM task force are working to finalize a set of common indicators to be used by the winterization partners to allow for comprehensive analysis of the winterization intervention. The indicators will cover aspects related to expenditures, impact of winterization assistance, and quality of service / beneficiaries satisfaction.

Harsh Weather condition TF update	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The Harsh Weather Conditions (HWC) task force consisting of INTERSOS, ACTED, WFP and UNHCR will have their second meeting in the 8 Nov in order to discuss the way forward for the preparation of harsh weather conditions. - The need to operationalize the TF resides in both the acknowledgment that the winter season is still a period of major risks for both refugees and vulnerable Jordanians and in specific situations unconditional cash transferred alone do not constitute the best response and in the need to coordinate activities in order to ensure coverage of the countrywide needs. - So far, the HWC partners have confirmed the availability of NFI and hot meals to respond to the needs of the vulnerable beneficiaries affected by the harsh weather. The HWC task force will review the response modality and alert system in harsh weather condition. - Partners interested to join/ support the HWC TF are encouraged to contact Luca Sangalli (bn.jordan@intersos.org)
