- •392 in Reception and Identification Centers
- •78 in protective custody

Waiting list does not include referrals of unknown location carried out during pre-registration exercise. Waiting list includes 186 separated children.

9,920 Total number of UAC referrals to EKKA from 1 Jan 2016 to 15 November 2017. Out of the total:

- •9,264 boys (93%)
- •656 girls (7%)
- •590 <14 years old (6%)




Number of places available in UAC shelters (filled, pending assigned cases) vs. Numbers of additional requests for placement on waiting list

(Safe spaces, Police Stations, RICs,



UAC Shelters (transit and long-term)

- Current: 51 UAC shelters with total 1,151 places. (increased from 423 places in March 2016)

- Planned: 2 new shelters with total 30 new places

Safe Zones* (short-term)


- Current: 8 Safe Zones for UAC with total 240 places.

- Planned: 2 new Safe Zones with total 60 new places

*Safe Zones are designated supervised spaces within accommodation sites which provide UAC with 24/7 emergency protection and care. They should be used as short term (maximum 3 months) measures to care for UAC in light of the insufficient number of available shelter places. Safe Zone priority is given to UAC in detention as well as other vulnerable children, in line with their hest interests




