
IRAQ: Camps Intentions Survey Round 2 National Level, January 2018






This Intentions Survey was carried out by REACH in partnership with the CCCM Cluster in 61 camps across Iraq hosting a total of 113,076 households (574,251 individuals). The survey was administered to 5,731 households, corresponding to 37,922 individuals through a random sample* between 12 December 2017 and 14 January 2018.


Area of origin



Are you currently planning on returning to your area of origin (AoO)? By governorate of origin***




What is the condition of your house in your area of origin?




Planning to return to area of origin

If yes, will you be going to your original home in your area of origin or will you live somewhere else?




- Original home

A random GPS sampling technique was applied in each camp, resulting in a 95% confidence level and a 10% margin of error at camp level, as well as a 99% confidence level and a 2% margin of error at the national level.









