2.	Measles/ Scabies Update		
	Reported Scabies Outbreak In Abra School:		
	Reports received stated more than 100 children affected.		
	UNHCR conducted a visit to the school took place on 26 April to verify the reports and discuss the way forward.	Reem (UNHCR)	
	17 cases were reported and confirmed to have scabies and had started treatment; initially reported information was exaggerated and many misconceptions on scabies were observed		
	Recommendations were shared to better deal with such situations in the future, particularly pertaining to the cultural sensitivity/ stigma towards diagnosis with Scabies.		
	➤ IOCC was present on 2/5/2018, when the school resumed its activities.		
	Scabies Outbreak in Kfar Roumane:	Jamil (IMC)	
	IMC completed the response to the outbreak, visited households and provided medications and health education; several visits and follow up were done by the medical and community health outreach teams.

	UNICEF provided one-hour-session on measles.
