| Introduction | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Welcoming to new colleague Ms. Lina Younis as part of the technical team unit/ UNHCR, as Shelter Associate. | Allma - UNHCR |
| Partner update | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - NRC continued PRM shelter rehabilitation PQRM: shelter rehabilitation, flex modality for rehabilitation and cash for rent. This year the aim is to also include energy efficiency shelter rehabilitation target (FLEX+) for a greener agenda. NRC also is running cash for rent assistance funded by other donors. Other interventions also cover WASH rehabilitation activities in consortium with other partners. - NRC also continues to assist the PWD members of beneficiary households with tailored Inclusion kits to enhance the accessibility of the rehabilitated shelters. In camps, and through UNHCR fund, NRC continues maintain and repair shelters in camps in addition to conducting approximately 14 M USD of distribution through the year. - Several publications are in the pipeline concerning shelter and settlements interventions and will be shared when published. - Updates on camps: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - NRC is exploring WASH rehabilitation in camps. - NRC are finalizing two internal publications regarding urban shelter programs: carbon footprint report of previous project on renewable energy and energy efficiency on the household level, and school rehabilitation focusing on energy efficiency and water reservation. Further, NRC will be part of the publication of DG ECHO publication on environmental initiatives within two months. | Nathalia- NRC, Dina- NRC |
