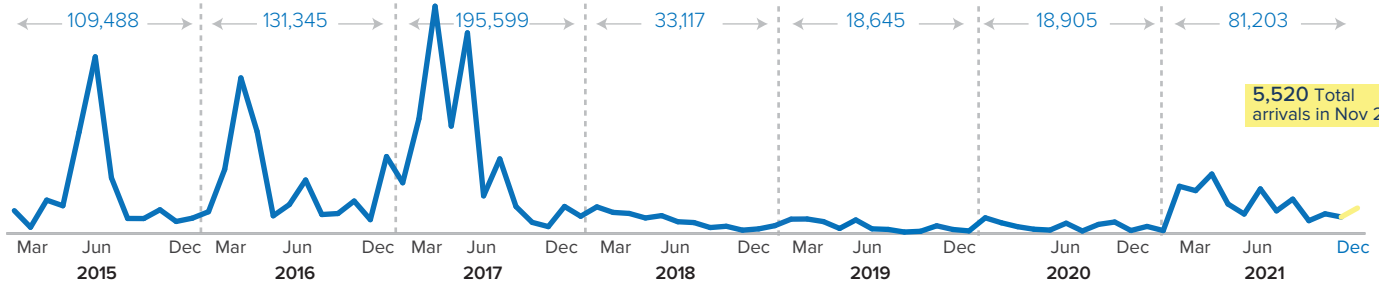

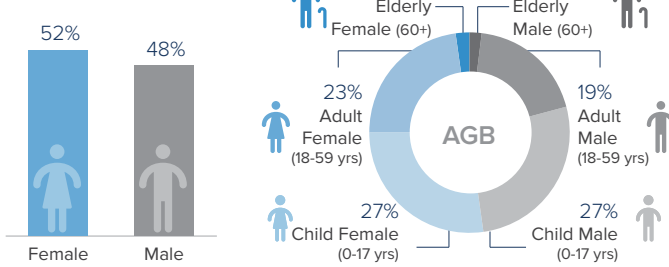

## Monthly Arrival Trends (2015-2021)



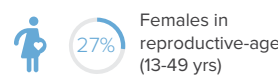

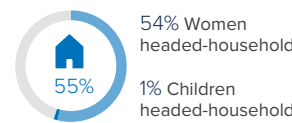

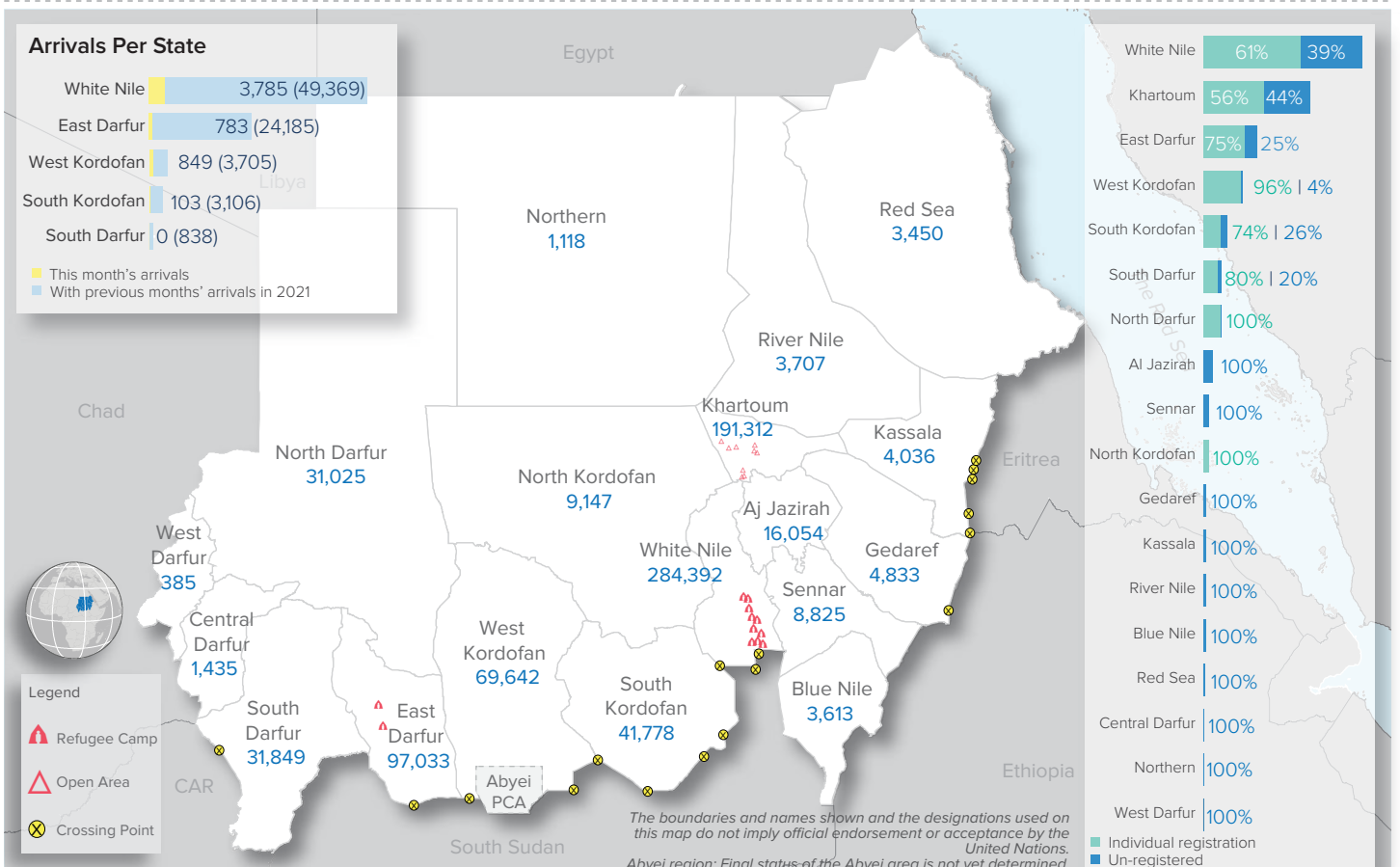
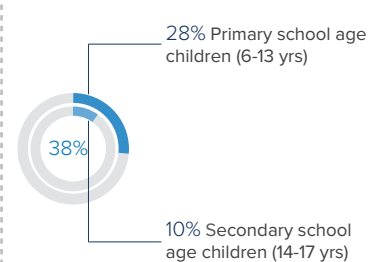
## Reproductive-age Women/Girls<sup>2</sup>
