


#### VERIFIED IDP SITES IN DHOBLEY TOWN AS OF NOVEMBER 2021




Map of verified IDP sites in Dhobley - November 2021

#### **Assessment overview**

IDP site verification exercise was conducted in Dhobley in November 2021 led by the JUCRI, WRRS, SEA, UNHCR, MC, CARE, WASDA, SAAH, Alight, DRC, NRC, SFH and COOPI. 4 IDP sites were identified hosting 2,680 households or 16,538 individuals. This is the first IDP Site Verification held in the district.

## People living with disability

Using the washington group disability questions, statistics of people living with disabilities were

1 97 (54% Female) have difficulty with seeing (even wearing glasses)

75 (45% Female) have difficulty with hearing (even using a hearing aid)

**46** (54% Female) have difficulty with communicating and/or understanding

150 (42% Female) have difficulty with walking and/or climbing stairs

46 (46% Female) have difficulty with dressing and/or washing

100 (32% Female) have difficulty with remembering/concentrating

# **Eviction Risk Mapping**

514 (3.1%)

IDP sites were assessed based on their risk of eviction. Several factors were put into consideration such as IDP site tenure, type of agreements in place and whether an eviction notice has been issued recently.

75% of IDP sites have been classified as having extreme (0%) and high (75%) risk of eviction

75% of sites have land owner authorized occupancy type of land tenure

50% of sites have no agreement in place

50% of those that have agreements have oral agreements

100% of those that have agreements have no agreed end dates

None of sites have been issued with eviction notice within the last 3 months

### Flood Risk Mapping

IDP sites were assessed based on their risk of flooding.

1 IDP sites (25%) have been classified as extreme (always floods) and high (floods frequently)
