


### VERIFIED IDP SITES IN SOUTH GAALKAYO AS OF JANUARY 2022




#### **Assessment overview**

A joint IDP site verification exercise was conducted in South Gaalkayo in January 2022. The operation was led by ADESO, CPD, DEH, DRC, DRRDO, GCRI, Geyfane Foundation, IMC, IRC, KAF, KHEYRAT CBO, NoFYL, NRC, Somali Aid Foundation, SOSDA, SVDG and WISE. 61 IDP sites were identified hosting 16,446 households or 96,917 individuals. Compared to the last site verification conducted in March 2021, there was a increase of 4 IDP sites and 4,737 Households or 28,707 individuals.

### People living with health difficulties

Using the washington group disability questions, statistics of people living with health difficulties were derived

people living with health difficulties

1,149 (49% Female) have difficulty with seeing (even wearing glasses)

676 (51% Female) have difficulty with hearing (even using a hearing aid)

703 (45% Female) have difficulty with communicating and/or understanding

**990** (48% Female) have difficulty with walking and/or climbing stairs

818 (62% Female) have difficulty with dressing and/or washing

818 (54% Female) have difficulty with remembering/concentrating

# **Eviction Risk Mapping**

5,154 (5.3%)

IDP sites were assessed based on their risk of eviction. Several factors were put into consideration such as IDP site tenure, type of agreements in place and whether an eviction notice has been

25% of IDP sites have been classified

39% of sites have landowner authorized occupancy

57% of sites have agreement in place

57% of those that have agreements have written agreements

69% of those that have agreements have no agreed end dates

15% of sites have been issued with eviction notice within the last 3 months

## Flood Risk Mapping

IDP sites were assessed based on their risk of flooding.

8 IDP sites (13%) have been classified
