


VERIFIED IDP SITES IN CABUDWAAQ AS OF APRIL 2022





Map of verified IDP sites in Cabudwaaq - April 2022

Assessment overview

An IDP site verification exercise was conducted in Cabudwaaq in April 2022. The operation was led by the CCCM Partner ARD, GECPD, HOPEL, NoFYL, NRC, SCI, SPL and GCRI. 24 IDP sites were identified hosting 14,064 households or 83,925 individuals. Compared to the last site verification carried out in October 2021, there has been an increase of 4 IDP sites, 2,642 households or 11,554 individuals.

People living with disability

Using the washington group disability questions, statistics of people living with disabilities were derived

10,533 (13%) people living with disability

2,622 (50% Female) have difficulty with seeing (even wearing glasses)

1,693 (49% Female) have difficulty with hearing (even using a hearing aid)

1,211 (47% Female) have difficulty with communicating and/or understanding

2,668 (48% Female) have difficulty with walking and/or climbing stairs

1,203 (50% Female) have difficulty with dressing and/or washing

1,136 (52% Female) have difficulty with remembering/concentrating

Eviction Risk Mapping

IDP sites were assessed based on their risk of eviction. Several factors were put into consideration such as IDP site tenure, type of agreements in place and whether an eviction notice has been issued recently.

42% of IDP sites have been classified as having extreme (21%) and high (21%) risk of existion

92% of sites have communal ownership/permanent ownership

58% of sites have agreement in place

93% of those that have agreements have oral agreements

14% of those that have agreements have agreed end dates

21% of sites have been issued with eviction notice within the last 3 months

Flood Risk Mapping

IDP sites were assessed based on their risk of flooding.

6 IDP sites (25%) have been classified as extreme (always floods) and high (floods frequently)
