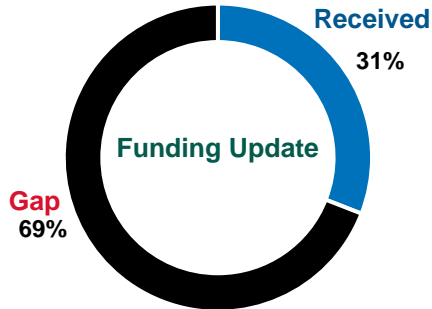

- 52 did not report

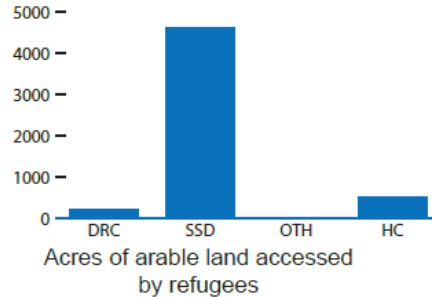
Budget

- Gap **US \$90.5M**



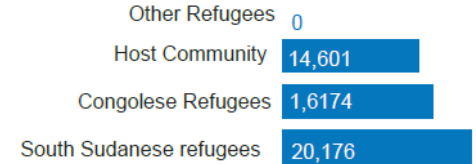
Households reached with Agriculture vs Targeted

- HHS reached - 70,000

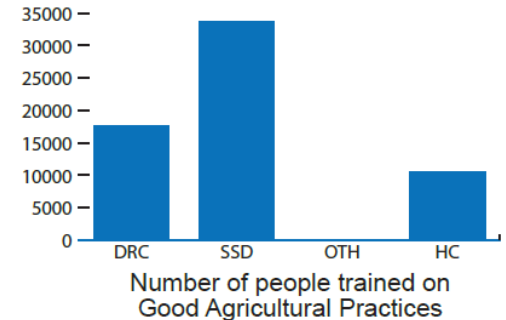

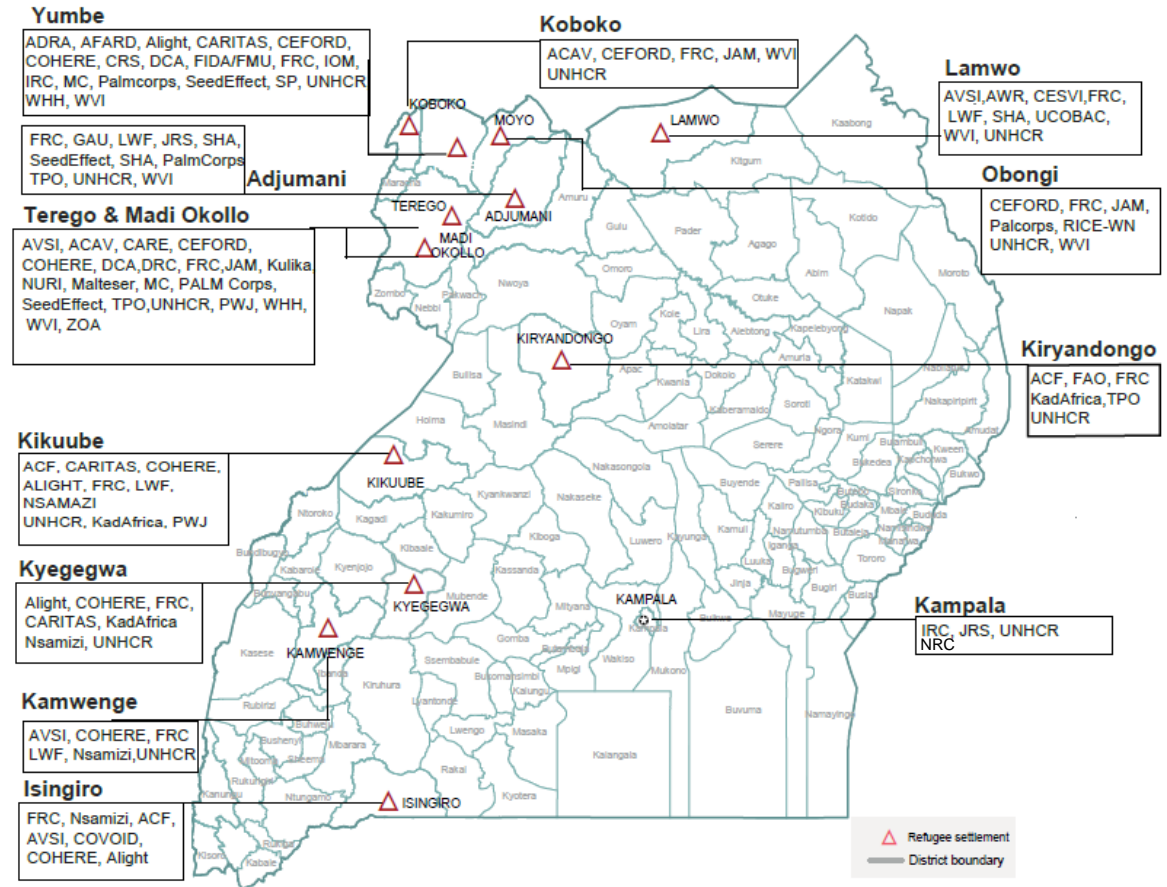
